

Who is Eligible?



Any person who has a permanent disability, or is a parent or legal guardian of a person with a disability, who has been a resident of Kentucky for at least the last six months, and who has the ability to repay the loan may apply.

A nonprofit organization that provides assistive technology to individuals with disabilities may also apply if it can demonstrate how the adaptive equipment will be used for potential customers.

What can be Purchased with the Loan?



Assistive Technology may include, but is not limited to:

- Vehicles and modifications
- Computers and adaptations
- Mobility devices (wheelchairs, scooters and prostheses)
- Home modifications
- Augmentative communication devices
- Communications devices
- Hearing aids
- Environmental Control Units

What are the Terms?



How much and for how long . . .

You can borrow up to \$25,000. The length of the loan depends on the life expectancy of the equipment.

Limited income or poor credit what to do . . .

KATLC is designed to help persons who would not qualify under traditional loan programs. All sources of income will be considered the same as employment income.

Who Approves the Loan?



KATLC reviews the application for disability and assistive technology eligibility and then forwards it to the financing agency. Customers will be notified within two to three days of the decision.
